PRODUCT HIGHLIGHTS

- **Simple and easy to use:** No measuring. Just add the pre-measured bag of Matting Agent to the 5 gallon pail of finish and mix in. The seal is ready to use.
- **Non-toxic, and Non-flammable:** Matting Agent is safe to handle and poses no serious health hazards. As a dust it can be irritating and a simple dust mask is recommended.
- **Does not deteriorate:** Matting Agent can be stored indefinitely. There is no shelf life.
- **Does not add color or affect color:** Matting Agent added to a color seal does not affect the color and does not add any color to clear seal.
- **Economical:** Use Matting Agent only when needed. No need to carry stock of gloss and mat finished sealers.

USES

Add Matting Agent to any solvent based acrylic sealer immediately before applying the sealer to the floor. This can be used in any application where a reduced gloss finish is desired.

MATTING AGENT

HOW TO USE:

Matting Agent should be added to the sealer just prior to applying.

1. Add the contents of one bag to one 5 gallon pail of sealer.
2. Stir in thoroughly. Do not use a mechanical mixer if using a sealer made with flammable liquids such as xylene or acetone.
3. Stir occasionally during application. Use with adequate ventilation - Product dust could cause possible discomfort, coughing and/or sneezing.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT:

Wear personal protective equipment including respirator, gloves and safety glasses. Sweep or vacuum spillage and collect in suitable container for disposal according to local, state and federal regulations.

FIRST AID:

IF INGESTED: Do not induce vomiting Get Medical Help Immediately.

IF IN EYES: Flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes, lifting both eyelids. Get Medical Help.

IF ON SKIN: Rinse off thoroughly with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
