



# COLOR RELEASE AGENT

## **HOW TO USE:**

**INSTALLATION:** Color Release Agent is sprinkled or spread (broadcast) onto fresh concrete with a masons brush after troweling or finishing operations are complete, but prior to starting stamping or embossing procedures.

**COMPOSITION:** Color Release Agent is a powder blend of concentrated color pigments milled together with surface conditioners and lubricating agents.

**COLOR & FINISHES:** Antique Release is available in 25 standard colors and plain. Two or more Color Release Agent colors can be used in combination to create different patterns or contrasting effects. Typically a dark shade of Color Release Agent is applied over a light shade of Color Hardener or colored concrete to create a contrasting effect.

**LIMITATIONS:** Color Release Agent must be applied to freshly-placed concrete before the concrete hardens. It is not designed to permanently bond to the concrete surface. Surface appearance may vary depending on application technique, finishing method, weather conditions, curing and sealing methods and the preparation and composition of the concrete mix material

## **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT:**

Avoid breathing dust/fume/gas/mist/vapors/spray. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Use respirators. Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed. Dispose of contents/ container according to local, state and federal regulations.

## **FIRST AID:**
